



PHOTO EXHIBITION

The G. & A. Mamidakis foundation, for the past 15 years, in terms of the Art Symposiums, has been presenting significant works of the Contemporary Greek and International artists, which take place at the Minos Beach Art Hotel, in St. Nicolas, Crete.

This year, a rare photo exhibition by Dimitris Papadimos will be hosted, supporting the initiative of the Municipality of St. Nicolas' Culture Organization.

This exhibition, themed "St. Nicolas, Places & People during the 60s" presents in 42 black-and-white photos the personality of the city then, the enticing landscapes and the locals' daily act, as captured by D. Papadimos' lens.

Really interesting are also his unpublished stills from the making-of of "Celuit qui doit mourir" by the one and only Jules Dassin, which is based on Nikos Kazantzakis' book entitled "Christ Recrucified", along with pictures of Minos Beach, which truly was, the pearl of the town of St Nicolas.

A special photograph album, composed by 82 photographs, will be presented at the same time, edited by PODAN and the G. & A. Mamidakis foundation, assisted by the photographer Maria Stefosi.

The G. & A. Foundation's President and owner of Minos Beach Art Hotel, Mrs. Gina Mamidakis, has kept supporting with unreduced passion, devotion and love such remarkable works of art since 1990.

Significant exhibitions of Greek and foreign creators have been hosted at the Minos Beach Art Hotel, with huge success. It is a place which hosts art masterpieces. The communal space is decorated with paintings. The gardens have turned into a permanently open sculpture exhibition of famous Greek and International artists.

The photo exhibition will be held Saturday July 19th, at 20:30 hours, at Minos Beach Art Hotel and will last until late September.
